



FACILITIES AND DAILY SCHEDULE

The daily agenda of the workshop begins at 8:30am in the classroom of the museum's visitor center where you will hear one to three faculty presentations depending on the schedule for each day. We will end each day at about 5pm, although after a dinner break on Wednesday evening, Dr. Pilgrim or I will conduct an orientation tour of the *Hateful Things* exhibition. Of course, during regular breaks and planning time, you can see our 23-minute orientation film about Mark Twain produced by Ken Burns and our permanent exhibition called *I Have Sampled This Life* about Twain's incredible career.

Six wireless laptops with a printer will be accessible to you throughout the workshop, but you are also strongly encouraged to bring your own laptop if it is possible to do so. A guided tour of the historic Mark Twain House will take place on the first day, which will allow you to enjoy the

beautiful Gilded Age mansion where Mark Twain lived and raised a family while writing nearly all of the novels for which he is most famous. There will also be time for visiting our research library or re-visiting the historic house later in the week.
